

The Sarah Jamison Keller Scholarship

This full tuition scholarship is awarded annually to a senior majoring in English who demonstrates ability to write scholarly analysis of an aspect of English language or literature.

Who is eligible to apply: IUPUI junior English majors (who will have senior status in Fall 2008) who are residents of Indiana. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.3 for all undergraduate courses and not less than a 3.5 cumulative average for all courses in English. To receive the award during the following spring semester, a cumulative GPA of 3.7 in all fall semester English courses is required.

Ray Russo Faculty/Student Technology Award

This awards benefits students interested in working in a mentoring relationship with faculty on developing new teaching technologies. It honors the memory of Professor Ray Russo, faculty in the Purdue University School of Science at IUPUI.

Who is eligible to apply: Undergraduate Liberal Arts majors. Students must work with faculty members to develop a project which will help bring new pedagogical technologies in course design and delivery into the classroom. Preference is given to students majoring in English, but all majors may apply.

How to apply: Complete the online application form Applications must include the following: 1) Project description (1-2 paragraphs); 2) Student statement: Why are you interested in this project and why do you believe you should receive this scholarship? Explain your career plans and any other aspects of personal interest in higher education which you deem significant. (Approx. 500 words. No more than 2 pages.); 3) List other scholarships or awards that you have received and for which you are being considered. List the name of the scholarship or award, the total amount awarded and the semester(s) to which it applies. The Faculty Letter of Recommendation must include: Why this student is being nominated to work on this project.; What experience and abilities the student bring to the project; any other information that may be helpful to the selection committee in determining qualifications of the nominee.
